Sore throat

For children over 1 year old and adults

For consideration of antibiotic therapy for moderate sore throat with a moderate likelihood of bacterial cause.


What causes a sore throat?

It can be caused by a viral, or rarely, by a bacterial infection in school children 15-30% and in adults 5-15% group A streptococci.

How long does a sore throat last?

Improvement of sore throat in 2-3 days, re-gardless of whether the infection is bacterial or viral.
